2011 National Human Rights Consciousness Week Celebration

Republic Act No. 9201 or the National Human Rights Consciousness Week Act of 2002 enjoins all government agencies, including government-owned and controlled corporations, state universities and colleges, and all levels of education/learning institutions, both state and privately owned to celebrate the week through meaningful and appropriate ceremonies and activities and make people aware of their basic and fundamental human rights.

Under RA 9201, December 4 to 10 of each year is declared as National Human Rights Consciousness Week. The declaration coincides with the international celebration of the universal declaration of human rights. For this purpose, a committee composed of the following was created to take the lead in the planning of meaningful activities and in the national implementation meant to effect a week-long celebration.
