MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO

ALL HEADS OF CONSTITUTIONAL BODIES; DEPARTMENTS, BU-REAUS AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT; LOCAL GOVERNMENT UNITS; GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS; AND STATE UNIVERSITIES AND COLLEGES

SUBJECT

: 105th Philippine Civil Service Anniversary Celebration

The Philippine Civil Service celebrates its 105th anniversary this year with the theme, "Isulong ang Dangal ng Serbisyo Sibil". This year's theme seeks to highlight the role of civil servants in strengthening the integrity of the institution they serve. Moreover, it underscores the vital role of the 1.5 million workforce in the task of nation-building and in the attainment of national development goals and objectives.

The Civil Service Commission will be at the forefront of this year's Philippine Civil Service Month festivities in September. All government agencies and instrumentalities are enjoined to participate in the following activities to be undertaken at the national, regional and agency levels:

GOVERNMENT-WIDE ACTIVITIES

Simultaneous Flag-Raising Ceremonies and Inter-faith Prayer Activity September 19 (Monday), Philippine Civil Service Day

At 8:00 a.m. on September 19, 2005, Philippine Civil Service Day, all government agencies shall simultaneously conduct the usual Flag Raising Ceremony in their respective offices. To signify oneness in the entire Philippine civil service, agencies may also carry out the singing of the *Awit ng Serbisyo Sibil* and the holding of an inter-faith thanksgiving celebration as part of the usual Monday morning assembly.

Conferment of the 2005 Presidential Lingkod Bayan, the Dangal ng Bayan, the CSC Pagasa Awards and the first Career Executive Officers (CEO) Awards

September 28 (Wednesday), 2:00 p.m., Cultural Center of the Philippines Main Theater

All heads of agencies and representatives of different government agencies are invited to the recognition rites dubbed *Parangal...Pasasalamat 2005*. The conferment of awards to outstanding public service exemplars in the various awards categories highlights this year's Philippine Civil Service anniversary celebration. Moreover, the said event shall also include the first awards conferment rites for Outstanding Career Executive Officers (CEOs).

Undertaken in partnership with the Cultural Center of the Philippines (CCP), the recognition rites shall feature the Philippine Philharmonic Orchestra, the Philippine Madrigal Singers, choral groups of selected government agencies and surprise artists.

Agencies are enjoined to send as many officials and employees as possible to the said activity.

2005 National Public Sector Labor-Management Congress

September 22 (Thursday), 2005, Ramon Magsaysay Hall, Social Security System, East Avenue, Quezon City

Spearheaded by the CSC, the one-day Congress shall be participated by representatives from both the management and the employees' organizations nationwide. The activity aims to orient the participants on the Amended Rules and Regulations Governing the Exercise of the Right of Government Workers to Organize (IRR of E.O. 180). The election of employees' representatives to sit in an observer status in the Public Sector Labor-Management Council (PSLMC) will also be held during the said event.

Awit, Tula at Kwento ng Galing sa Serbisyo Publiko

Agencies are enjoined to encourage their officials and employees to come up with their own *awit*, *tula*, *kwento* and other literary pieces to be read and interpreted during the flag-raising ceremonies and other agency activities in September. They may also read selections from the "2004 Awit, Tula at Kwento Tungkol sa Galing ng Serbisyo Publiko" which may be accessed through CSC's website, www.csc.gov.ph.

ACTIVITIES WHICH MAY BE UNDERTAKEN AT THE AGENCY LEVEL

Kick-Off Activities

For the conduct of the traditional kick-off activities for the celebration at the agency level, a *kapit-opisina* type of activity may be undertaken where a host agency may serve as the venue for the set of activities.

♦ Bida Ka!

This activity seeks to highlight the collective impact of the role or contribution of a specific sector or select group of employees i.e. drivers, utility workers. Agencies will identify their *Bida Ka!* group and come up with activities or simple ways of honoring them.

Retirees' Homecoming

Agencies may conduct a socialization activity for their retired employees. This can be a venue for the retirees to touch base and build networks for their

co-retirees and co-workers. Agencies shall design appropriate activities for this purpose.

Livelihood Activities/Livelihood Skills Development

Agencies may form partnership with government and non-government organizations for the conduct of entrepreneurial seminars/programs that shall provide employees with essential information, skills and opportunities to earn additional income.

"Palengke" corners in the agencies may be set-up and mini-tiangges organized for employees to be able to market their products.

Obra

Agency officials and employees who are budding painters, sculptors and visual artists may opt to showcase their talents, creativity and skills in various visual arts and crafts through a mini art exhibit in their respective offices.

Likewise, budding photographers may mount an exhibit of their action photos of civil servants in the workplace and/or government offices as architectural works of art.

Apart from being a venue for talent sharing and showcasing, it can also be a good starting point for network-building among artists and art enthusiasts as they continually harness their common interests. It may also even be a venue for artists to market their art pieces.

Assemblies/Traditional Activities

As in the past years, agencies celebrate the Philippine Civil Service Anniversary through joint activities that promote and develop the overall physical, emotional, spiritual and cultural well-being of their personnel. These may include:

> Ecumenical celebration/Inter-faith Prayer and Thanksgiving Celebration

Physical Fitness Activities

Agencies may use *Bidyo Ehersisyo*, *Bisyo Ko To*, a 30-minute exercise routine produced in VCD by the Philippine Sports Commission and Streetpark Productions in partnership with the CSC. CSC Regional and Field Offices are provided with VCD copies of the video which agencies may reproduce using their own resources.

> Family Day

To promote camaraderie among family members of government employees, a half or one-day session of fun, games and other socialization activities may be undertaken by agencies. > Opening of agency exhibit of accomplishments, programs, projects

Agencies' achievements, services, and the like, may be exhibited/ displayed for public viewing.

- Symposia/Conference/Lectures on the following topics that contribute to the wholistic development of public sector employees may be undertaken in cooperation with relevant partners in the academe and other GO/NGO/CSO partners: Spirituality in the Workplace; Balancing Family Life and Work; Occupational Safety and Health; Healthy Lifestyle Workshops/Health Education Seminars; Stress/Time Management Seminars; GAD Awareness Sessions/Anti-Violence Against Women-related topics and other activities or fora.
- ➤ Display of 105th PCS Anniversary Streamer/Banner

Agencies are enjoined to display the 105th PCS anniversary streamer/banner in their respective units. The format and color guide for the said streamer is attached for their guide.

For the PCS Anniversary Month, agencies may also opt to undertake activities such as medical and dental missions, outreach programs, environmental awareness, which all seek to instill social responsiveness among civil servants.




