**SUBJECT** 

Celebration of the National Women's Month

Pursuant to Republic Act 6949 which declared March 8 as a working holiday to be known as National Women's Day, and Presidential Proclamation Nos. 224 and 227 providing for the yearly observance of the month of March as the Women's Month, the Civil Service Commission hereby enjoins once again the active participation and involvement of men and women in government in the celebration of the Women's Month by holding fitting activities in their respective agencies.

This year's theme is: Nagkakaisang Kababaihan Tungo sa Kapayapaan at Mabuting Pamamahala in recognition of the significant contributions of women to good governance.

On March 8, 2004, the National Commission on the Role of Filipino Women, together with other agencies, is spearheading various activities for the National Celebration of the International Women's Day which will be held at the Cuneta Astrodome, Pasay City.

All government agencies are enjoined to send a delegation and authorize the participation of government officials and employees on official time in the March 8 activity.

Expenses relative to this month-long activities may be charged against the agency's allocation for Gender and Development (GAD) Programs as provided for in the 2004 General Appropriations Act.
