SUBJECT: Celebration of the 12th National Arts Month in February 2002

Pursuant to Proclamation No. 683 declaring every February of each year as National Arts Month, the National Commission for Culture and the Arts has been tasked to spearhead the 12th National Arts Month in February 2002 with an overall theme: "ARTS FOR PEACE". The theme may be translated into major Philippine languages. Depending on the focus and direction of its arts activities, an agency, region, province, city, and municipality may choose to have its own sub-theme.

In general, the observance of this event has three-fold objectives:

- To promote and popularize the Filipino's artistic creations;
- To promote the creativity of our young artists, particularly those who are pioneering in new forms of artistic expression in film, literary arts, dance, music, media arts and visual arts; and
- To foster peace through arts.

Specifically, this year's celebration aims to highlight arts as instrument for peace.

Agencies are encouraged to undertake activities in accordance with their own capabilities. These may be in the form of music, dance or theater performances, film or visual arts exhibits, visits to museums or cultural sites, arts workshops or any other form relevant to the theme and the selected sub-theme of the agency. Further, heads of agencies are requested to provide their own streamers to be displayed at their building façade throughout the month of February. Calendar of activities, posters and other promotional materials shall likewise be disseminated within and outside the agency premises. Materials shall be provided by the National Arts Month Coordinating Committee.
