MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

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ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND AGENCIES OF THE NATIONAL GOVERNMENT, LOCAL GOVERNMENT GOVERNMENT - OWNED UNITS. AND CONTROLLED CORPORATIONS WITH ORIGINAL CHARTERS AND STATE

SUBJECT :

Repeal of MC No. 42, s. 1993

Pursuant to CSC Resolution No.96-4906, dated August 5, 1996 the Commission has repealed MC 42, s. 1993 and adopted the following classifications of positions which require skills not measurable by paper and pencil examination:

"Category I

:

-refers to positions in the list marked as Annex "A" which shall have a qualification standard (QS) wherein the required eligibility can be obtained only by passing a skills test administered by the Technical Education and skills Development Authority (TESDA).

"Category II -

refers to positions in the list marked as Annex "B" which shall have a QS wherein the required eligibility can be obtained by completing one (1) year of satisfactory actual work performance. "Category III
refers to positions in the list marked
as Annex "C" which shall have a QS
wherein no eligibility shall be
required."

The Commission has further adopted the following policies in the grant of eligibilities and security of tenure:

- Appointees to Category I positions who possess the appropriate eligibility shall be under probation only for a period not exceeding six (6) months;
- Appointees to Category II positions who do not possess the required eligibility shall be under temporary status until the required eligibility is obtained;
- Appointees to Category III positions are not required to have an eligibility but shall be under probation for a period of not more than one (1) year before security of tenure is obtained;
- Eligibilities required for Category I positions shall be issued by the Commission upon application and presentation of TESDA skills Certificate;
- Eligibilities required for Category II positions shall be issued by the Commission upon application and presentation of documents evidencing completion of one (1) year of satisfactory actual work performance.

This repeals all other CSC issuances inconsistent herewith.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from publication of Resolution No. 96-4906 in a newspaper of general circulation.

Eligibility Security of Tenure Repeal of MC No. 42, s. 1993

RESOLUTION NO. 964906

WHEREAS, under MC No. 10, s. 1977 and Res. 435, s. 1980, appointees to positions requiring skills which cannot be measured by the usual paper and pencil test but through actual work performance over a period of time may be granted eligibilities after completing one (1) year of satisfactory service;

WHEREAS, the skills required by certain positions originally included in the coverage of CSC MC No. 10, s. 1977 and Resolution No. 435, s. 1980 were later found to be measurable by the skills test being administered by Technical Education and Skills Development Authority (TESDA);

WHEREAS, under MC No. 42, s. 1993 those who pass the skills test administered by TESDA shall be conferred the appropriate eligibility;

WHEREAS, since the issuance of the abovecited Memorandum Circulars and Resolution, certain developments occurred which made it necessary to review the list of positions which require skills not measurable by the usual paper and pencil examination;

WHEREAS, there is a need to periodically review policies, rules and regulations which determine merit and fitness and revise the same in the light of changing conditions;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Commission hereby RESOLVES to repeal MC No. 42, s. 1993 and to adopt the following new classifications of positions which require skills not measurable by paper and pencil examination:

- "Category I refers to positions in the list marked as Annex "A" which shall have a qualification standard (QS) wherein the required eligibility can be obtained only by passing a skills test administered by the TESDA.
- "Category II refers to positions in the list marked as Annex "B" which shall have a QS wherein the required eligibility can be obtained by completing one (1) year of satisfactory actual work performance.
- "Category IIIrefers to positions in the list marked as Annex "C"
 which shall have a QS wherein no eligibility shall
 be required."

The Commission further RESOLVES to adopt the following policies in the grant of eligibilities and security of tenure:

- Appointees to Category I positions who possess the appropriate eligibility shall be under probation only for a period not exceeding six (6) months;
- Appointees to Category II positions who do not possess the required eligibility shall be under temporary status until the required eligibility is obtained;
- Appointees to Category III positions are not required to have an eligibility but shall be under probation for a period of not more than one (1) year before security of tenure is obtained;
- Eligibilities required for Category I positions shall be issued by the Commission upon application and presentation of TESDA skills Certificate;
- Eligibilities required for Category II positions shall be issued by the Commission upon application and presentation of documents evidencing completion of one (1) year of satisfactory actual work performance.

This repeals all other CSC issuances inconsistent herewith.

This Resolution shall take effect after fifteen (15) days from publication in a paper of general circulation.
