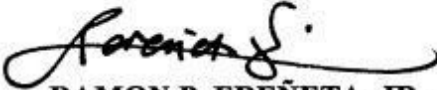

SUBJECT : Observance of the Moral Guidance Week

Presidential Proclamation No. 472 dated October 8, 1989 has declared the second week of October of every year as the Moral Guidance Week for Public Servants.

This year, the National Social Action Council (NASAC) through the Commission on Moral and Spiritual Development (CMSD) is spearheading the celebration from October 6 to 12, 1996 with the theme "**MAKA-DIYOS NA PAMILYA, TUNGO SA MAUNLAD NA BANSÀ**".

In this week-long celebration, we enjoin all government offices to extend full support to NASAC by undertaking appropriate nation-building activities through practical exercise of human values involving the employees. It is suggested that the Monday (October 7) Flag Ceremony include a short talk on values or a topic in the Code of Ethics for Public Officials and Employees (R.A. 6713) and other similar activities.
