Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in

college; or High School with relevant

vocational/trade course

Experience: 1 year relevant experience

Training : 4 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : None required

## 2. BROADCAST OPERATIONS TECHNICIAN II - SG-11

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in

college; or High School with relevant

vocational/trade course

Experience : 2 years relevant experience

Training : 8 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : Career Service (Subprofessional)

Equipment Technician

## 3. BROADCAST OPERATIONS TECHNICIAN III - SG-13

Education : Completion of two years relevant studies in

college; or High School with relevant

vocational/trade course

Experience : 3 years relevant experience

Training : 16 hours of relevant training

Eligibility : Career Service (Subprofessional)

Equipment Technician
