MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT: OBSERVANCE OF THE 94TH ANNIVERSARY

OF PHILIPPINE INDEPENDENCE DAY

In commemoration of the 94th Anniversary of Philippine Independence on June 12, 1992 and considering that the Philippine Flag is the symbol of our national identity, all officials and employees in the government service including those who are on flexitime schedule, are hereby enjoined to attend the flag ceremony to be held in their respective offices on Monday, June 8, 1992.

The flag raising ceremony shall include the singing of the National Anthem, recital of the "Panatang Makabayan" and the pledge of allegiance to the Constitution.

The guidelines for conducting the flag ceremony in all government offices and institutions prescribed under Memorandum Circular No. 71 dated August 10, 1988 of the Office of the President shall be strictly observed.

Every government official and employee is enjoined to comply with this Circular.
