SUBJECT: Attendance and Participation of Government Employees in the "Bayanihan ng mga kawani ng Gobyerno para sa mga Biktima ng Mt. Pinatubo"

To show our concern to our brothers/sisters affected by the Mt. Pinatubo eruption, the Civil Service Commission, in connection with the 91st Anniversary celebration of the Philippine Civil Service on September 13-19, 1991, will spearhead the "Bayanihan ng mga kawani ng Gobyerno para sa Biktima ng Mt. Pinatubo on September 16, 1991, at the areas affected by the eruption in Region 3.

Several activities have been lined up to be undertaken by the government employees among them are the construction "Bayanihan Style" of three (3) units of houses, sandbagging in the river banks of Pampanga, stress debriefing and other activities which may be conducted in the evacuation centers.

In this regard, heads of departments and agencies are requested to send at least ten (10) employees from their respective departments/agencies/offices to participate in this activity. The attendance of government personnel in this undertaking is hereby authorized on official time and at government expense.

Additionally, there is an urgent need for empty sacks for the sandbagging of river banks in the disaster area. In view hereof, you are enjoined to solicit from your employees two (2) empty sacks each for this purpose. The empty sacks may be submitted on or before September 6, 1991 thru our Civil Service Field Office or to any member of the Council of Personnel Officer, Personnel Division in your department/office.

Names of participants shall be submitted to the Office for Career Systems and Standards thru telephone Nos. 98-32-82 and 99-18-48, locals 262 and 249, on or before September 3, 1991.

Your support and cooperation in this undertaking is enjoined.
