

SUBJECT : Authority to Participate on Official Travel in
the Forthcoming Plebiscite on the Organic Act
for the Cordillera Autonomous Region

In connection with the plebiscite on the Organic Act for the Cordillera Autonomous Region on January 30, 1990, all government office personnel who are natives of concerned provinces are authorized to go on official travel to their hometowns. This is aimed at ensuring a more dynamic and more meaningful political exercise, as such directly concerns the future of their respective provinces.

Participation in said plebiscite may constitute extensive information dissemination and discussion of various issues on regional autonomy. Enhancement of political awareness, not being partisan in character, does not in any way violate the Civil Service Law and Rules.

Heads of offices may allow their employees to travel only on a maximum of five (5) working days but should see to it that the major operations of their offices will not be disrupted.
