SUBJECT: Observance of the 90th Anniversary of the Philippine Civil Service

The Philippine Civil Service will observe its 90th anniversary from September 13 to 19, 1990. The week-long celebration will feature daily activities highlighting facets of the ideal bureaucracy.

The activities will revolve around a theme that been developed for each day. Each theme will reflect characteristics that government employees are expected to embody in their daily routines.

Thus, Civil Service Week will emphasize creativity, excellence, productivity, transparency, physical fitness and the spiritual requirements of the civil servant.

The week-long celebration will be capped by a program on September 19 which will include the conferment of Presidential Awards for outstanding work performance and the first awards for government officials and employees who have best exemplified the values under RA 6713 or the Code of Conduct and Ethical Standards for Public Officials and Employees. The first Congress of National Workers, a mass gathering of government workers, will also present resolutions to the country's leadership in keeping with this administration's commitment to consultation participation of affected persons in policy formulation as well as in the implementation of government programs that affect them. President Corazon C. Aquino will address the Congress and confer the awards.
